1. Did I say what type of protist (protozoa, algae, decomposer) my protist is?
 - a. Did I say how I know which type of protist it is?
2. Did I say how it gets its energy (autotroph, heterotroph, other, or some combination)?
 - a. Did I describe how it gets its energy (provide a definition)?
3. Did I describe what the organisms looks like?
4. Did I describe where the protist lives?
5. Did I say if it is unicellular, multicellular, or lives in a colony?
 - a. Did I say what it means if it is unicellular, multicellular, or lives in a colony?
6. Did I say what cell parts (organelles) or other body parts it has?
 - a. Did I say what those parts do or what they are?
7. Did I say how the organism reproduces (sexually, asexually, or both)?
 - a. Did I describe how it reproduces in that way?
8. Did my project use at least 10 vocabulary terms (see handout 31 for a sample of vocabulary terms)?
 - a. Did I define those terms as I used them? *You probably did!*
9. Did I hand draw at least one picture or diagram of my protist?
 - a. Did I label important parts?
